



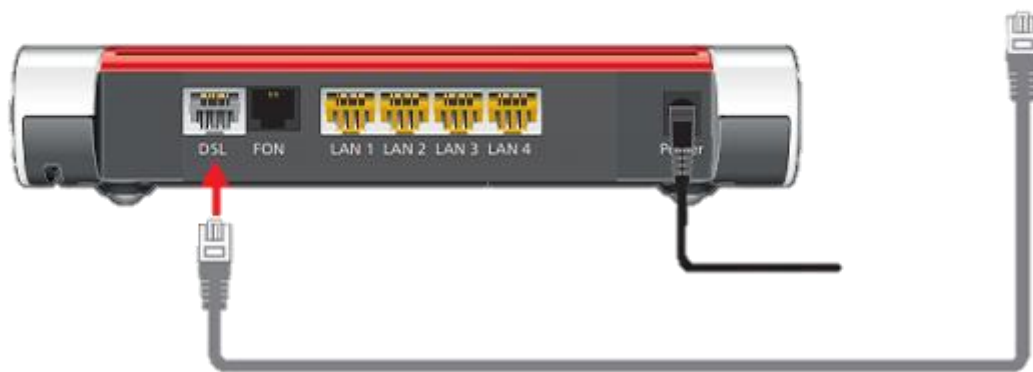

Installation / Internet Connection

1 1 Connection of the FRITZ!Box

1.1 Connection of the DSL cable

Connect the long grey network cable to your FRITZ!box.



1.2 Connection of the FRITZ!Box with the phone socket

Insert the narrow end of the cable into the phone socket using the supplied Reichle adapter (110).

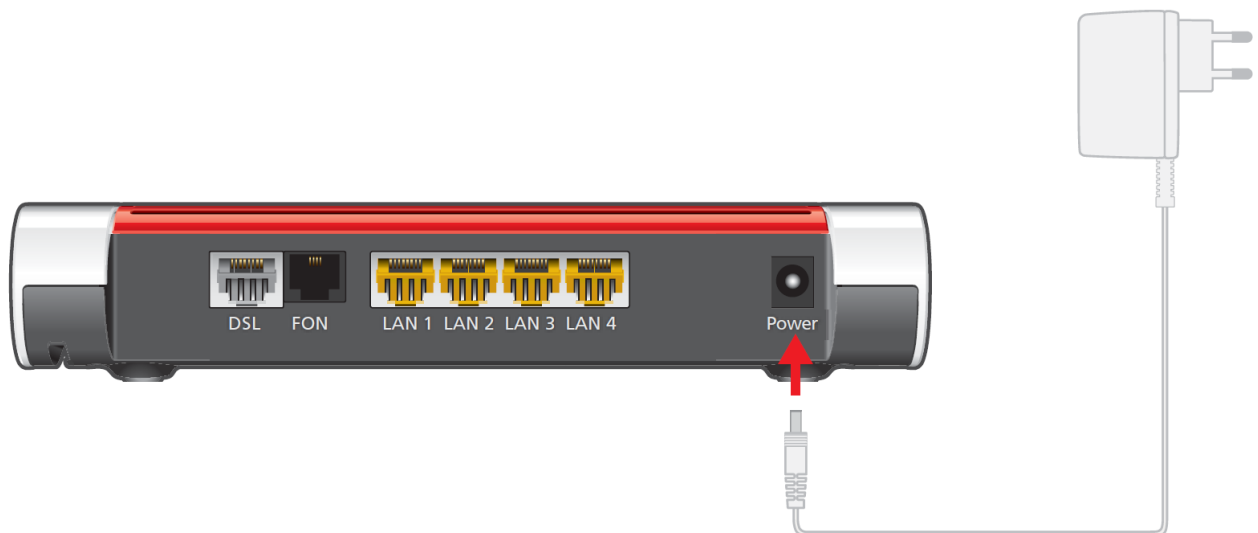


If your phone socket has a RJ-11 port, you can plug in the cable without using a Reichle adapter.

1.3 Connection of power adapter

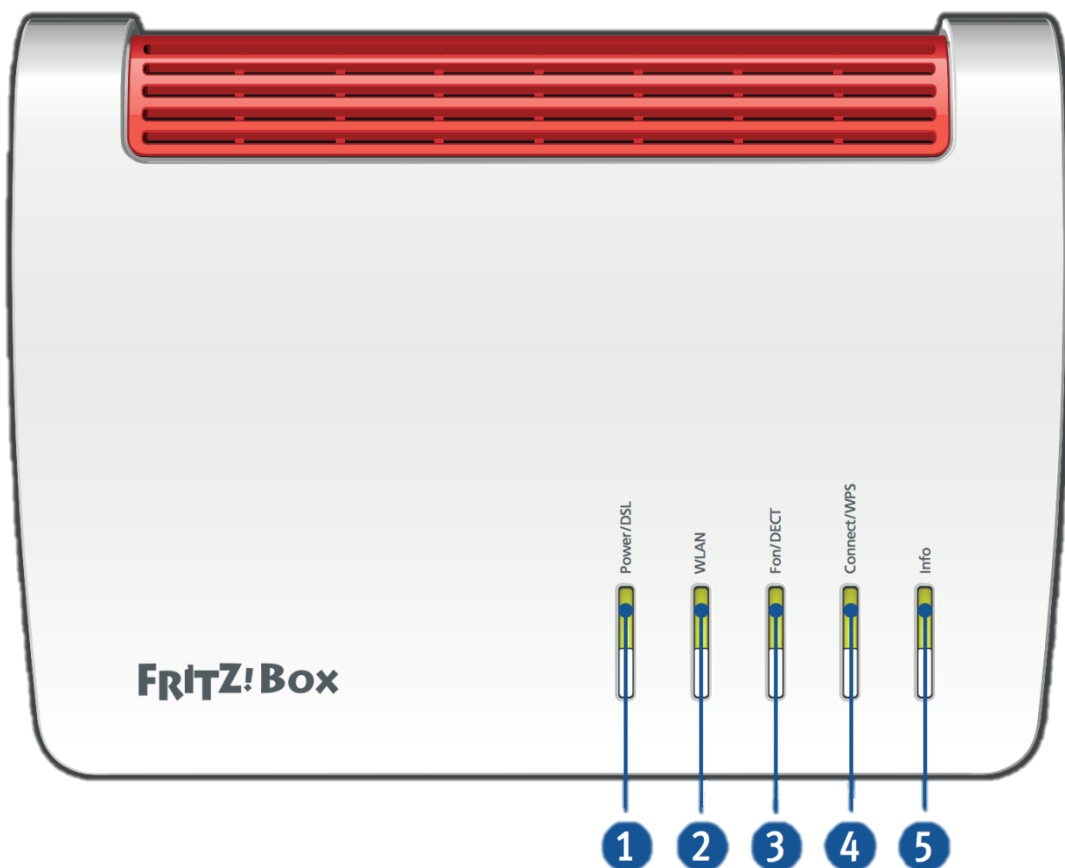
Connect the power adapter to your FRITZ!box. The "Power/DSL" lamp will start flashing green when the adapter is connected to the power supply.

The FRITZ!box is now configured automatically. The process takes about 5 - 10 minutes, after which the FRITZ! box detects the Internet connection and, if available, the telephone settings. The FRITZ! box will reboot several times. The "Power/DSL" lamp then stops flashing and lights up constantly green.



1.4 Description LEDs

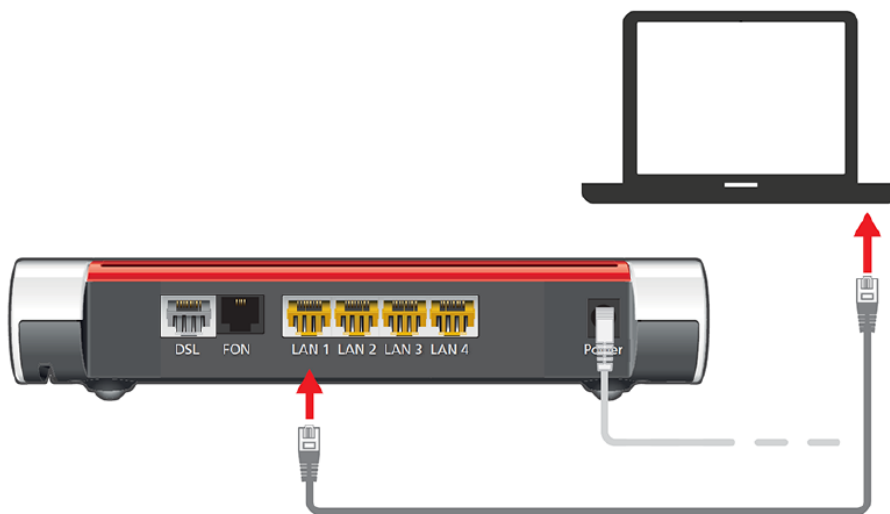

2 Network connection to your Computer

2.1 Connection with network cable

If you want to connect your computer with a network cable, connect the network cable to a free LAN port on the FRITZ! box and to the computer's LAN port.



2.2 Wireless network connection

If you want to connect your computer via wireless network connection (WLAN), you need the name of the wireless network connection and the password. The wireless connection for your FRITZ!box has already been preconfigured. The WLAN name (SSID) and the password for the wireless internet connection can be found on the back of your FRITZ!box.

2.3 Access to the Fritz!Box

First of all, you have to connect to the user interface of the Fritz!box. Make sure that your computer is connected to the Fritz!box via LAN cable or WLAN.

Then enter "fritz.box" or "192.168.178.1" in the address line of your Internet browser (e. g. Firefox or Internet Explorer). The FRITZ!box is already password-protected at delivery. This password can be found on the sticker on the bottom of your FRITZ!box. If you have not changed this password, you can use it to access the FRITZ! User Interface.
